In the Southeastern U.S., The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) is a forerunner in sustainable airport operations. In 2013, a time when few of the nation's big airports were prioritizing sustainability, GOAA leadership resolved that economics alone would not outweigh environmental and community concerns.

ecoPreserve LLC participated in the development and implementation of GOAA's original Sustainability Management Plan (SMP) which was unanimously approved by the GOAA Board in 2014. This SMP created achievable goals for continuous improvement in operations, maintenance, purchasing, engineering, and construction.

To demonstrate transparency and accountability, ecoPreserve collects data and publishes it in online SMP performance reports. These reports quantify the Authority's progress in reducing greenhouse gas, focusing on energy, transportation, solid waste, and other areas related to SMP goals.
